However, this increased responsibility does have its advantages -- more help in the garden. There is plenty to look at and admire in Inga Moore's detailed illustrations but I find the portrayal of the mice themselves somewhat sinister which leaves me with what is perhaps an unjust antipathy towards the book. However, older infants and young juniors will probably not share this aversion and thus should enjoy the book to the full.
